

Drop In Hockey at Redwood Acres

Welcome to Drop In Hockey, sponsored by The Humboldt Timberwolves Inc. We are a non profit organization with a Board of Directors, many of whom are players.

Our goal for Drop In is Hockey for the love of the sport and exercise. We will not tolerate unsportsmanlike conduct and expect all players to self regulate and abide by the rules set forth by USA Roller Sports.(<http://usarollersports.org/>) You can access the rule book online. We reserve the right to ask any player to leave the session without refund if we feel players are engaged in unsportsmanlike conduct

On the occasion that we do not have a designated referee officiating, any Humboldt Timberwolves Board Members that are present will be identified and be the designated officials for the session. They become a Player/Official and have the authority to call and penalize any fouls. If you accidentally trip someone; stop the play, apologize, and give the other team possession of the puck. In the event that a player does not report his own foul and it is witnessed by an official, play will be stopped and the officials will consult on the matter. Here is the protocol:

- 1. If a foul is observed, a time out will be called and the “officials only” will consult on the matter and dispense the appropriate penalty. If an Official is involved in a penalty, they are not to be a part of the consultation.
- 2. If you feel you are being fouled by another player, bring it to the attention of an Official.
- 3. Part of a penalty may include being asked to leave the premises for the rest of the session. This requires you to leave Redwood Acres entirely. If you are asked to leave, you still may be subject to further disciplinary action.
- 4. 3 Strikes and you are out means if you are asked to leave on three separate occasions, you are not welcome to play. This action may only be overturned by Board action.
- 5. Do not use The Humboldt Timberwolves email list for your personal matters without permission (screening). Abuse of this communication tool may result in a “strike” (see #4). - 6. If you feel you have been dealt with unjustly, you may request a review with the Board.
